Continuous improvement of environmental behaviour and sustainable development

An integral part of decision-making at all levels of the company's management is the setting of conditions for the prevention and the continuous improvement of the quality of the environment and sustainable development. The company manages its production activities in such a way as to limit the negative impacts of these activities on individual areas of the environment as effectively as possible, both in the short and long term.

Compliance with binding requirements for environmental protection

PMP Montex s.r.o. manages its activities in accordance with the binding requirements and ethical principles. The company guarantees compliance with the set requirements in the environmental area within technical and economic possibilities.

Responsibility and awareness of employees

Part of the education of the company's employees is a program focused on environmental issues and familiarization with the possible risks of hazards to the quality of individual areas of the environment and on increasing the responsible environmental behaviour of each individual.

Protection of natural resources – utilization of new technologies

Plans in the area of protection of natural resources and restrictions on their use are implemented by the company through the development and application of technologies aimed at recycling and recovery of waste generated during construction activities.
